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Students' Perception Of Using Google Form In English Test At English Education Departement Of STAI Hubbulwathan Duri

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ABSTRACT

In this research, the writer conducted a descriptive survey. The sample in this study was 32 students. The data collection techniques used tests; questionnaires and documentation. According to the poll results, 23.5% of the majority of students said that using Google Forms helped them learn to read and made the process easier. Regarding the use of Google Forms, 11.25% of students are neutral, 15.5% of students disagree, 8.25% of students definitely disagree, and 42% of students strongly agree. These findings reveal many drawbacks to using Google Forms as well as the perception of students that using them positively improves learning despite the possibility of cheating.

Personal variables including academic dishonesty, a lack of online assessment abilities, the trustworthiness of online assessment systems, inadequate preparation for and attention to formative online assessment, and others make online assessment challenging. After research, encourage students to comment and gather feedback (Debson: 2008). Consequently, a teacher should think about testing Google Forms. Google Forms is one of the evaluation tools mentioned above that is utilized globally for a variety of purposes. In 2008, Google LLC created Google Forms, the company's first evaluation tool. According to (Debson: 2008), Google Forms is a survey management tool that is a component of Google's online Google Docs Editors suite. Users may build forms, surveys, and quizzes with the help of Google Forms, a free online tool that also enables collaboration and form sharing. The teacher's job is made easier with Google Forms in education, particularly in assessment. It serves as an alternative, technique for evaluating student work in distance learning.

Based on this fact, it can be concluded that many students of STAI Hubbul Wathan are not motivated when learning English. There are many media innovations that can be used in the teaching and learning process so that students are motivated in learning at school, one of which is the use of the Google form. Google form can improve learning because they can replace the use of whiteboards to store information, allowing students to interact with each other with the teacher (Fisher, 2017)

Writing is not only done on paper, but also through other media innovations. Students who are less interested in writing can be tried through a padlet. Writing is a way of communicating with other people, figuring out what they want to write about, and exploring thoughts. The main purpose of writing is communication. In learning to write English, it can be in the form of text, one of which is descriptive text.

Descriptive text tells something that is seen, felt, smelled, tasted, and or heard, imagining objects, places, or people in his mind (Anggun, 2016). Descriptive text is a type of text that is described in detail. Motivation is needed by students in writing descriptive texts because descriptive texts require students to know the object well. However, the students still did not meet the target expected by the teacher and many of them were still lazy and less motivated in writing descriptive texts as in the symptoms that the researchers described earlier.

Based on the description above, the researcher is interested in studying the research entitled "Students' Perception of Using Google Form in English Education Departement of STAI Hubbulwathan Duri".

Method

This research used a descriptive quantitative approach with survey design. Creswell (2013:18) stated a descriptive survey is a research design that intends to describe quantitatively the tendency, behavior, opinion of a certain population by taking some samples as the representation. Surveys permit the researcher to summarize the characteristics of different groups or to measure their attitude and opinion toward some issues (Ary et al., 2010: 372). In the educational research, the issues can be included school improvement or any classroom instructional.

Then, the researcher used survey design in this research because it fits with the purpose of the study that is students' perception on the use of Google Form in English test at english education departement of STAI Hubbulwathan duri. Therefore, related to the purpose of the survey research design, this research was conducted to investigate the students' perception on the use of Google in English test at english education departement of STAI Hubbulwathan duri.

Finding and Discussion

The result of the research showed that Total rating percentage of students' perception using Google Form in learning English 31,3%. It was agreeing category. These categories showed the respondents agree to use Google Form application in teaching learning process. Based on the questionnaires were also analyzed quantitatively to determine the mean and the standards deviation. The writer used excel to analyze it. The respondents were asked to rate their agreement to the thirteen statements. It is showed mean score Agree (3). Overall mean is 1.74 and standart deviation is 33,34. The respondents gave positive responds.

- 1. If the alpha Cronbach score 0.00-0.20: less reliable
- 2. If the alpha Cronbach score 0.21-0.40: rather reliable
- 3. If the alpha Cronbach score 0.41-0.60: enough reliable
- 4. If the alpha Cronbach score 0.61-0.80: reliable
- 5. If the alpha Cronbach score 0.81-1.00: very reliable

Because of the score of Cronbach's alpha was 0,969, it could be concluded that the instrument was very reliable. Therefore, the items of the questionnaire could be used to gather data.

Based on the table above, 21,9% respondents respond agree about uses Google Form was held in classroom. Learning the English test via was a good idea. It was easy for me to become skillful in discovering information via Google form 54.4% agree. Learning the English language using Google form was convenient for me 65.6% agree. Google form was convenient for academic engagement purposes 54.1% agree. Padlet allows me to academically engage with peers and lecturers at any time and any place 54.7% agree. I found that Google Form is useful in my English language learning 60.7% agree. Using Google form was effectively improved my English language learning 60.7% agree. My

performance in English language learning was improved by the use of Google form 67.2% agree. My performance in English writing had improved through the use of Google form 55,7% agree. Interaction via Google form helped me to become active in English language activity 54.1% agree. In the future, I used Google form in learning the English language 65.6% agree. Total rating percentage of respondents' respond was 54.5%.

Conclusion

The current study aimed to investigate how English language learners see using Google Forms as a formative assessment method online evaluation. The study's preliminary found revealed that EFL students using Google Forms as a formative assessment method language evaluation. The study's second found revealed that cheating was likely to occur on the online Google Forms test, with participants at testing to the prevalence and ease of cheating. This conclusion was in line with that of the body of research. In any situation, fraud was a widespread occurrence, claim King et al. (2009). Despite the advantages of online language testing, EFL instructors should be ready for cheating on test day. Therefore, teachers should encourage students to act ethically and warn them that lying on summative exams won't benefit them in the long run.

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
